

Classwork

The morning classes are a very important part of the *cúrsa Gaeilge*.

Every effort is made to motivate students and to stimulate their interest to participate fully in classwork. A wide range of teaching aids, audio/ video tapes, slides, charts, overhead projectors etc are used in presenting classwork. Each class has specific objectives, and classwork incorporates varied teaching approaches and strategies suited to the learning styles of the different age groups. The focus of classwork is on developing speaking and communication skills, improving vocabulary and fluency levels and increasing students confidence in using *Gaeilge*.

The *Cúrsa Gaeilge* taught in *Coláiste Lurgan* will benefit your child's preparation for the Junior/Leaving Certificate examination by:

- Developing comprehension skills
- Increasing vocabulary substantially,
- Greatly improving fluency.

Students are allocated classes primarily according to their school year and also according to the outcome of the interview.

- 1st year students
